SOCIAL JUSTICE WEEK 2024

Isaiah 35:4-7a

James 2:1 -5

Mark 7:31 -37

“His Ears opened and he spoke plainly”

St. James presents two men, **one with gold rings and fine attire and the other a poor person in shabby clothes.**

We could say that the first has received justice and the second injustice. God prefers the shabby person, not because he is better but because he is shabby, because he is poor, and because he suffers injustice in one way or another.

There are many root causes of social injustice. Among others: **racism, economic and social inequality, class discrimination, lack of freedom, exploitation, subordination, marginalization, human trafficking, slavery, colonization, gender equality, homelessness, harassment, child abuse, poverty and migration.**

Injustice anywhere is a threat to Justice everywhere.

Hope and (self) confidence are the two things with which we need, to fight injustice today. Truth, Faith, Strength are not enough.

We must have the Hope to prove and see that injustice is happening and we must have the (self) confidence to stand up and try to win against it, try to defeat it.

There are 120 terribly unjust trouble spots in the world today, not only Ukraine, Gaza, Yemen and Sudan. I bet we can't name the other 116. Injustice is so endemic.

Near us and in us there is much injustice. This can be overwhelming in fact paralyzing. But **we must not be deaf, blind nor dumb (mute).**

Jesus put his finger into the deaf and dumb man's ears, spitting, touched his tongue; and said
“Ephphatha!” “Open Up!”

The man's ears opened, and he spoke plainly.

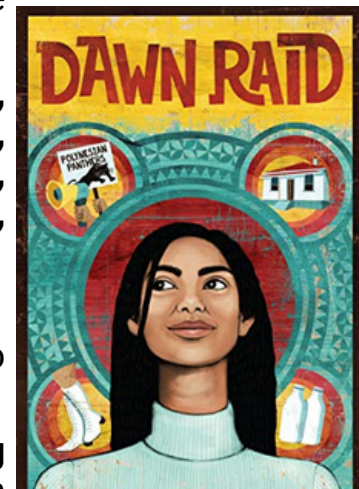
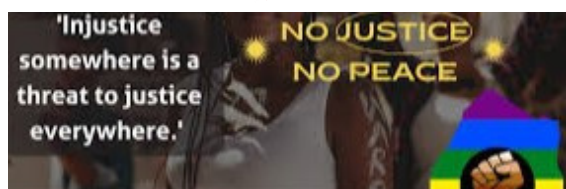
With Hope and Confidence let us listen, see and speak of our poor people in shabby clothes.

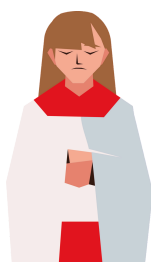
Start Date: 12 September
